

## **A STUDY OF THE BOOK OF JUDE #3**

#1. Jude 1:8 Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

A. REFERENCE TO Jude 1:4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

B. JUDE DESCRIBE THE FALSE TEACHERS (LIBERALS) IN THREE WAYS

1. FILTHY DREAMERS DEFILE THE FLESH

2. DESPISE DOMINION - REJECTS AUTHORITY

3. SPEAK EVIL OF DIGNITIES - WE NEED TO RESPECT THE OFFICE IF NOT THE OFFICER (EXAMPLE Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.)

#2. Jude 1:10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

A. BUT THESE SPEAK EVIL OF THOSE THINGS WHICH THEY KNOW NOT - THE THING OF GOD (NATURAL MEN)

B. BUT WHAT THEY KNOW NATURALLY, AS BRUTE BEASTS - 2Pe 2:12 But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption;

C. IN THOSE THINGS THEY CORRUPT THEMSELVES - CONDEMN THERE OWN SELVES

D. THREE EXAMPLES Jude 1:11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

1. WOE UNTO THEM! FOR THEY HAVE GONE IN THE WAY OF CAIN - CAIN BELIEVED IN RELIGION AND GOD, BUT WANT TO COME TO GOD ON HIS ON TERMS AND NOT GOD'S

2. RAN GREEDILY AFTER THE ERROR OF BALAAM FOR REWARD - 2Pe 2:15 Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; (BALAAM WENT WITH BALAK NUMBERS 22:7-41)

3. PERISHED IN THE GAIN SAYING OF CORE

#3. Jude 1:12 These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you,

feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; (JUDE USES THREE OTHER THINGS TO DESCRIBE FALSE TEACHERS)

A. THESE ARE SPOTS (ROCKS UNDER THE WATER) IN YOUR FEASTS OF CHARITY, WHEN THEY FEAST WITH YOU, FEEDING THEMSELVES WITHOUT FEAR

B. CLOUDS THEY ARE WITHOUT WATER, CARRIED ABOUT OF WINDS

C. TREES WHOSE FRUIT WITHERETH, WITHOUT FRUIT, TWICE DEAD, PLUCKED UP BY THE ROOTS

#4. Jude 1:13 Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

A. RAGING WAVES OF THE SEA, FOAMING OUT THEIR OWN SHAME; (THEY WERE NOISY BOLD AND DANGEROUS IN THEIR PROFESSIONS LIKE THE WAVES OF THE SEA)

B. WANDERING STARS, TO WHOM IS RESERVED THE BLACKNESS OF DARKNESS FOR EVER ( METEORS WHICH BURNOUT)
